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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- 1- Food safety certificate not available at time of inspection. At least one person currently working in this facility shall pass an approved food safety test within the next 60 days.
- 6- Coffee cups observed in handsink at beginning of inspection—removed during inspection. Handsink shall be available for use at all times.
- 29- Spray bottles of chemicals observed hanging from utensil sink drainboard.
- 32- Obtain ingredient lists for pastries.
- 33- Resecure loose shelf to wall above utensil sink.
- 34- Obtain test papers for checking sanitizer level in sanitizer compartment of utensil sink.
- 35- a) Replace missing door of ice machine.
b) Replace ripped door seals on 2-door storage refrigerator.
c) Remove duct tape on handle of undercounter refrigerator—replace/ repair door handle as needed.
- 36- Spoons observed stored in container of still water on undercounter milk refrigerator. Recommend installing dipper well for such storage. Paper cup observed in bulk food container—provide additional handled scoop.
- 39- Replace missing thermometer in milk refrigerator (40° F).
- 44- a) Organize misc. items, etc. on shelf unit near 2-door storage refrigerator.
b) Employee's personal food observed on various shelves in 2-door storage refrigerator. Store employee's personal food in labeled containers/ lunch boxes etc. so as to be separate from food for customers.
- 45- Provide cover for hole/ attic access in ceiling above janitorial sink. Replace cracked floor tiles and areas of eroded grout.
