OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: 6, 21- No hot water at restroom hand sink used by food handlers. REPEAT VIOLATION. Provide hot water to prevent spread of harmful bacteria.

44- Provide weather strip under screen door to prevent entrance of vermin.

45- Observed cracks in ceiling over dishwasher and food prep area and peeling paint on wall under food prep area. Repair to prevent physical contamination of food. Observed rain water leaking from air conditioning duct over kitchen entry. Repair to maintain floor in dry manner. Repair floors where needed to be smooth and easily cleanable.

Reinspection fees will be charged for all subsequent reinspections unless an acceptable corrective time schedule has been submitted and approved by this Department. If, for any reasons beyond your control, you cannot correct the indicted violations by the next scheduled time, call this office prior to the inspection day.
