**OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS**

- 14- No detectable sanitizer in dishwasher. Adjust/repair dishwasher to maintain minimum 50ppm. Replace inaccurate thermostat on dishwasher (reading 116°F during wash and rinse cycles, water 129°F-130°F with Inspector's thermometer).  
Note: Reported dishwasher rarely used. Obtain sanitizer testing strips for dishwasher and check sanitizer level each day used.
- 29- Observed unlabeled chemical spray container on shelf over utensil sink. Label as to contents.
- 35- Observed blocks of wood 4 X 4s supporting debris trap for dishwasher. Replace blocks with metal legs or other approved, easy to clean under and around, equipment. Clean metal flashing inside ice machine to remove black and tan residues.
- 36- Observed cracked/hard to clean plastic ice scoop on top of ice machine. Discard and provide easily cleanable scoop.
- 45- Clean floor sinks under dishwasher and utensil sink to remove accumulated residues.
