OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: 12- No lid observed on bottle of brown sugar at coffee condiment counter.

27- a) Can of domestic insecticide observed below handsink.

b) Use probe thermometer to check temperatures of potentially hazardous foods (ie: milk) at time of delivery.

33- Repair peeling countertop surface and trim strip on back counter in front dispensing area (remove tape on this area of the countertop).

35- a) Remove hard to clean wood shims/ supports under espresso machine legs.

b) Replace ripped, hard to clean plastic cover over mixer.

36- Ice scoop stored on cloth towel on ice bin; ice scoop stored on cardboard box on top of ice machine.

38- No cover on overhead light in ice machine room.

44- Back door left open. Keep exterior door closed or provide an air curtain or screen door if door is to be left open.

Reinspection fees will be charged for all subsequent reinspections unless an acceptable corrective time schedule has been submitted and approved by this Department. If, for any reasons beyond your control, you cannot correct the indicted violations by the next scheduled time, call this office prior to the inspection day.
