**OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS**

**30)** Observed open soda boxes stored on the floor in the bar. Open soda boxes shall be stored six inches off the floor.

**35)** - Clean interior of prep refrigerators (including the door seals) at cook line to remove buildup of food residues.

- Repair broken handle on prep refrigerator at cook line. Repair broken handle on microwave.

- Repair or replace broken insulation panel on the ice machine lid within 6 months.

- Clean soda nozzle holster to remove some pink / white residues.

- Replace ice bin with an NSF approved ice storage bin with an integral cold plate so that liquid waste drain lines do not pass through storage bin within 6 months.

**38)** Replace missing light cover at light in the hood. Install shatterproof light covers on lights above the bar.

**45)** Clean floors in hard to reach areas (i.e. behind / under equipment / shelving) throughout facility to remove accumulation of food debris / residues, dust and dirt.

**52)** Remove all unused equipment (i.e. cutting boards, meat saw, beer cooler, ice bin, etc.) so as to allow for proper cleaning.

NOTE: Upon change of ownership or remodel of this facility, self coved flooring shall be installed in the wait station area and in the bar.
