**6)** Provide a pump type soap dispenser at hand sink in wait station.

**7, 35)** Cooked rice was 110°F in rice cooker at cook line rather than 135°F or more as required. Rice was moved to walk-in cooler during inspection. Replace domestic rice cooker with NSF approved commercial unit.

**14, 40)** Observed several soiled wiping cloths on food contact surfaces and countertops. Wiping cloths shall used once or stored in a container of clean sanitizing solution. Wiping cloths used with raw animal products shall be stored separately.

**34)** Repair broken temperature gauge at dishwasher.
