DOG LICENSE INFORMATION

This information sheet is to remind dog owners in the unincorporated area that dog licenses are required by State of California Law and Butte County Ordinance:

- ✓ Within 30 days of acquiring a new dog or moving to the area
- ✓ When a puppy becomes 4 months of age

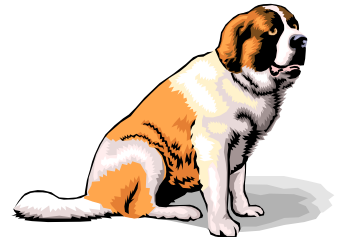
A Butte County dog license is the best identification your dog can wear. If your dog is lost, a license may hasten the return of your dog from Animal Control, or it may give a neighbor a chance to return your dog without Animal Control impoundment. Licensing also decreases the need for antibiotics treatment following an animal bite.
