43-1 - Fees charged for services.

The Butte County Public Health Department is authorized to charge, in addition to any other fees required by the County of Butte or the State of California, fees identified in Sections 43-5 through 43-17 of this chapter.

43-2 - Payment of fees required.

The fees specified in this chapter shall be paid at the time of the filing of the application or request for service. In no event will an application or request be determined or deemed complete and action taken thereon unless and until the applicable fees have been paid in full.

43-3 - Late renewal fees.

Late renewal fees for annually billed services shall be charged as follows:

- Payment received 0—30 days of billing date – 0%
- Payment received 31—60 days of billing date – 10%
- Payment received 61+ days of billing date – 50%

43-4 - Refund policy.

- (a) Refunds may be made for all fees erroneously paid or collected.
- (b) Refunds may be made for services not rendered. All refunds shall be less departmental costs (e.g., filing fee, plan review, inspection).
- (c) No refunds shall be made for renewal fees or annual operational permits.
- (d) Claims for refunds shall be submitted on Butte County general claim forms by the person who paid the fee.
- (e) Claims for refunds must be made within one (1) year of the date the fee was paid.
