

PUBLIC AND COMMERCIAL POOL INSPECTIONS

Public and commercial swimming pools in California must be constructed and maintained in compliance with applicable requirements of the California Health and Safety Code and California Code of Regulations. These regulations apply to all swimming pools except for single-family residence pools. To assist pool owners and operators, and to assure compliance with these regulations, Butte County Division of Environmental Health maintains a pool inspection program.



Swimming pool owners, operators, and maintenance personnel may call Environmental Health for questions regarding regulations for public swimming pools.



Environmental Health staff perform routine and complaint inspections of all public pools, spas, waders, and special purpose pools in Butte County. Most inspections occur in the summer months when the pools use is the highest.
