Oroville, CA –The Butte County Board of Supervisors announced the appointment of Paul J. Hahn as the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) effective September 13, 2010. Mr. Hahn’s three-year employment contract will be considered for approval on the next Board meeting scheduled for August 10, 2010.

Mr. Hahn has worked for Sacramento County for the past 20 years. For the past three years, he has been working as the Administrator of the Municipal Services Agency for Sacramento County. As the administrator, he manages 10 departments with 2,000 employees and is responsible for a \$1 billion budget that provides municipal services to more than 600,000 residents in the unincorporated areas of Sacramento County. Prior to that appointment, Mr. Hahn served as the Director of Economic Development and Assistant to the County Executive in the Department of Economic Development and Intergovernmental Affairs.

Mr. Hahn received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from Pennsylvania State University and a Masters of Public Administration from San Diego State University. "I appreciate the trust the Board has shown in selecting me as their new CAO," said Hahn. "I look forward to working with the Board of Supervisors, department heads, employees, and others to address the pressing issues Butte County is facing."

"We welcome Paul Hahn to Butte County and look forward to working with him as the County continues to deal with fiscal challenges," said Bill Connelly, Chair of Butte County Board of Supervisors.
