Butte County to Hold Free Foreclosure Prevention Workshop on January 9, 2012

Oroville, CA – Butte County officials announced that they will hold second foreclosure prevention workshop on Monday, January 9, 2012 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The workshop will be held at the Innovation Lab, 345 Huss Drive, Hegan Lane Business Park in Chico, CA. The public is invited to attend free of charge.

During the workshop, Dan Beveridge, Northern California's only HUD Certified Housing Consultant, will explain options for foreclosure prevention whether homeowners are current or behind with their mortgage payments. Mr. Beveridge, who currently provides one-on-one housing consulting for Community Housing Improvement Program (CHIP), will also discuss modification programs, how to communicate with banks, and tips for completing a loan modification packet.

A break-out session will be provided after the presentation and information will be available from Butte County service providers including:

- Butte County Department of Social Services;
- One-Stop Community Employment Centers;
- Butte County Department of Behavioral Health;
- Legal Services of Northern California; and
- PASSAGES Connection and Volunteer Services.

“Foreclosure is an issue facing many Butte County residents,” said Steve Lambert, the Chair of Butte County Board of Supervisors. “Having the tools to successfully navigate through the loan modification process is invaluable to those trying to maintain home ownership”. During the workshop, Butte County along with other community partners will provide information on some of the tools necessary to work toward a positive outcome.
