### **Butte County announces the appointment of Greg Iturria as Interim Chief Administrative Officer**

**Oroville, CA** – At its regular meeting today, the Butte County Board of Supervisors unanimously appointed Gregory G. Iturria as the Interim Chief Administrative Officer (CAO). The Board took this action to facilitate a smooth leadership transition after Brian Haddix announced his resignation on January 12, 2009.

Mr. Iturria assumes the Interim CAO position with extensive experience in county government and local government finances. Mr. Iturria led the re-organizations of departments and the development of new business systems in four California counties. This is also his 17<sup>th</sup> consecutive year managing a countywide budget.

Mr. Iturria has worked in the Butte County Administrative Office for the past seven years, initially as a Deputy Administrative Officer, and mostly recently as the Chief Financial Officer. Before working for Butte County, he served as the County Administrative Officer for Mariposa County and as the Assistant County Administrator for Yuba County. Prior to his service with Yuba County, he worked as a Budget Management Analyst, an Auditor/Accountant, and an Assistant Fiscal Officer for Lassen County.

“Greg has a wealth of experience in financial and budget management,” said Bill Connelly, Chair of Butte County Board of Supervisors. “His experience is particularly valuable as the county adjusts to big reductions in state funding and declines in major tax revenues.”

Mr. Iturria received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Public Administration from California State University, Chico. “Eight years ago, my wife and I discussed the need to settle in a community where we could raise our children. After looking at many desirable communities, we decided to move back to Butte County where I had gone to school. We absolutely love being a part of this community,” said Mr. Iturria. “I understand the enormity of the fiscal challenges our county is facing and will continue to do everything I can to serve the residents of Butte County.”
