WIC is served by the B-Line Bus #15S.

The new location is across the street from the Department of Employment Services building and in the same parking lot as Pete's Restaurant and the Regional Occupational Program.

The WIC program provides much needed supplemental nutritious foods to families. We invite all families to see if they qualify, especially given the current economic downturn. The program is not an entitlement program. It is a Federal grant program with a specific fund of dollars provided each year. The dollars are targeted to help pregnant women, breastfeeding women and children up to their 5th birthday. Additional benefits for participants include nutrition classes featuring healthful and affordable recipes, nutrition and breastfeeding counseling and referrals to other health and social services.
