MAGALIA – January 25, at 2:00 am, Sheriff's Deputies responded to Feather River Hospital in Paradise regarding two gunshot victims that were being treated at the hospital. Our investigation determined that Christina Anne Clark, age 44, of Paradise, and Elliot Charles Forbes-Patchill, age 23, of Paradise, had sustained gunshot wounds. The victims reported that the shooting occurred on Powellton Road near the "Forks of the Butte" in Magalia. They identified Travis Dalton Winslow, age 29, of Paradise, as the alleged shooter.

At 7:24 am, this date, the Sheriff's Office received a 911 call from a resident on Kolar Rd, Magalia, reporting that a suspicious person who was involved in a shooting, was at his neighbor's residence. Sheriff's Deputies responded to the location, identified the subject as Travis Winslow and, after interviewing him, arrested him for two counts of Attempted Murder.

The victims and Winslow are acquaintances; however the exact nature of their relationship and the motive for the shooting is unknown at this time. Both victims are being treated at a local hospital for serious injuries—a description of their injuries is not being released at this time. Winslow is being held at the Butte County Jail on \$1,000,000 bail. The investigation is open and continuing.
