On December 22, 2011 at approximately 8:26 AM, the Butte County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call from a male subject stating that he was a victim of a robbery that occurred on the 3900 block of Front Street, Dayton, CA. Deputies responded to the scene and contacted two adult males who lived at 3914 Front Street. The two males reported that three black male adults came into their home, tied them up, held them at gun point and stole approximately 10 pounds of processed marijuana. The suspects fled the area in a dark colored sedan.

One of the suspects has been identified as Calvin Walker, age 53 from the Bay Area. Walker is described as a black male adult, 5'6" tall, 165 pounds.

Suspect #2 is described as a black male adult, early 30's, 5'8" tall, 210 pounds with a black sweatshirt and jeans.

Suspect #3 is described as a black male adult, early 30's, 6'0" tall, 230 to 240 pounds, with black sweatshirt and jeans.
