The Butte County Sheriff's Office has developed several investigative leads that have led to a composite drawing of one of the three suspects that entered Michael Brumley's residence on Velma Way in Berry Creek on 8/15/09 and killed him.

The suspects in this case are described as follows:

The African American male adult 25-30 years in age, approx. 6'01 tall, clean shaven wearing a diamond stud in his left ear. A composite sketch of that suspect is attached to this press release.

The Hispanic male adult 35-40 years in age approx. 5'07" tall 185 lbs wearing blue jeans, white tennis shoes, black t-shirt and a red and black flannel over shirt. The Hispanic suspect had very unique facial hair that is described as a thin lined beard extending from his side burns down to his chin were it then makes a "W" shape on his chin. A composite sketch of this suspect will be released soon.

The Asian suspect is described as 20-25 years in age, approx 5'02" tall, wearing all black or dark colored clothing, long shoulder length hair that is all one length.
