On 09/02/11, at about 1430 hours, Butte County Sheriff Deputies responded to a 911 call from the 2600 block Chico River Rd regarding an assault where weapons may have been involved.

Upon arrival, Deputies located the victim, Tom Salgado, who had sustained moderate injuries from being hit with a metal pole. Salgado did not know why he was attacked but that the suspect was the estranged husband of the female homeowner. Salgado was transported to Enloe Hospital where he is undergoing treatment for his injuries, none of which are life threatening.

The suspect, Jasen Winters, age 33 of Chico left the scene prior to Deputies arriving. Deputies searched the surrounding areas as well as locations they were told the suspect may have gone. The deputies were unable to locate the suspect at any of these locations. Winters is allegedly armed with an unknown firearm which may have been brandished during this incident.
