

**NOTICE OF CURRENT
PROPERTY TAXES DUE**
(Revenue & Tax. Code, § 2609)

Troy Kidd, Butte County Treasurer-Tax Collector, hereby announces that regular secured tax bills will be mailed on or before September 30, 2023 to all property owners using the addresses shown on the tax roll. If you own property in Butte County and do not receive a tax bill by October 31, please contact the Butte County Treasurer-Tax Collector's Department at 530-552-3720, send an e-mail to taxes@buttecounty.net, or come into the office located at 25 County Center Drive, Suite 125 in Oroville.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not relieve the taxpayer of the responsibility to make timely payments.

The **FIRST INSTALLMENT** of 2023/2024 taxes are due and payable on November 1, 2023 and will become delinquent if not paid by 5 P.M. or the close of business, whichever is later, on December 11, 2023; thereafter a 10% penalty will be added.

The **SECOND INSTALLMENT** is due on February 1, 2024 and will become delinquent if not paid by 5 P.M. or the close of business, whichever is later, on April 10, 2024; thereafter a 10% penalty will be added plus the cost to prepare the delinquent tax records and to give notice of delinquency.

BOTH INSTALLMENTS MAY BE PAID when the first installment is due.

To pay by mail, send a check, cashier's check or money order to the Butte County Treasurer-Tax Collector, 25 County Center Drive, Suite 125, Oroville, CA 95965. Mailed payments must be **POSTMARKED BY THE DELINQUENT DATE** to avoid late penalties. To pay by credit/debit card or e-check, visit the Treasurer-Tax Collector's website located at www.buttecounty.net/ttc or call 1-844-882-3391. Payments may also be made in person at the Butte County Treasurer-Tax Collector's office located at 25 County Center Drive, Suite 125, in Oroville between the hours of 9 A.M. and 5 P.M., Monday through Friday, holidays excepted.

Payment via e-check through the Treasurer-Tax Collector's website is strongly recommended as the preferred method of electronic payment.

Payment by e-check using our website or toll free number is a FREE service for payment of property taxes.

Making tax payments by using your bank's online bill pay system is NOT recommended. If you choose to make payment using this method, please schedule your payment to be made at least 10 business days before the due date. The Treasurer-Tax Collector does not receive funds electronically from banks offering bill-pay services. All online bank payments are sent by paper check through the U.S. Postal Service; however, they are generally NOT postmarked, meaning the transaction is not complete until the Tax Collector physically receives and deposits your payment.
