As required by the 2011-2012 Butte County Grand Jury, the following is our written response to its findings.

In response to the 2010-2011 Grand Jury ethics training requirements, Richvale Recreation and Park District adopted a plan on February 17, 2011 and submitted it to Steven J. Howell August 1, 2011. We understood that this would satisfy the Grand Jury's requirements. Please advise if further action is needed in response to our Ethics Training.

With regards to findings F1 thru F9, we appreciate them, and consider them insightful to our district. We recognize the need for more organization and security for our district. We are appreciative of the Grand Jury's system of analysis, and that they contribute constructive recommendations for a better district. Our plan is to use these findings to develop procedures for future boards to utilize.

Concerning recommendation R1, we have already inquired on better maintenance and storage for district documents. We acknowledge that the expectation for board members to possess district records is not a prudent policy.

Regarding recommendation R2, we believe we had adequately complied with this, but perhaps the Grand Jury had not seen our response.

In response to recommendation R3, R5, and R6, they are all good recommendations for the board; with regards to recommendation R4, we continue to negotiate with Biggs Unified School District and anticipate a current lease to be in place yet this fall (2012).
