I. CALL TO ORDER

- a. Chief Probation Officer, Steven Bordin, called the regular meeting of the Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) to order at 9:04 a.m., on January 18, 2017, in the Tahoe Room located at 202 Mira Loma, Oroville, California.

II. SUB-GROUP COMMITTEE REPORTS/UPDATES

BUTTE COUNTY PROBATION

- Dwayne Martin, Program Manager, reported out on the first six months of PCS starts and transfer-ins; along with MS statistics for FY 16/17. A handout was provided.
- Mike Rogers, Supervising Probation Officer, reported out on the Re-Entry program. He states they are currently at the maximum amount of 20 persons allowed in this program. Chief Bordin also commented that they will be modeling the pilot program for the Transitional Age Youth program after the adult Re-Entry program; Butte County is one of 5 counties participating.
- Amy Asher, Probation Officer III, gave a report on PAC and current programming at the Chico Probation office. At the last PAC meeting in November 2016; there were a total of 22 providers attending; along with 59 offenders in attendance. She states they are very busy with lots of programming at the Chico site.
- Jennifer Hard, Program Manager gave a report regarding the Treatment Courts and the meeting of the Collaborative Courts, Drug Court and HIDE Court team members, who all met on January 17, 2017. She will be putting together all the information regarding the restructure model that had been discussed at the training this past July. She will provide an update to all involved within the next week; sending it out to all the team members so that they could move forward in implementing some of the new protocols.

BUTTE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

- Lt. Hovey gave an update on the ACS and various other programs the inmates are involved in. He also states things are going well at ACS. Also reporting out for BCSO was Lt. Agurkis regarding the jail and its operations. Sgt. Lyon spoke about the DUI program and those participants that are going through the program. He also spoke about the SCRAM (Secure Continuous Remote Alcohol Monitor) training class.

BUTTE COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

- Joel Chain, of Behavioral Health reported on their AB109 service delivery and client totals by month; along with client openings and services. Also reported were the service types from December 2015 thru December 2016. A handout was provided.

BUTTE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND SOCIAL SERVICES

- Shelby Boston, Director of DESS, provided her department's statistics to the CCP members present. She spoke about eligibility, DRC participation and their Medi-Cal, Cal-Fresh with no General Assistance grants for December. She also reported on the employment services side.

OTHER PROGRAMS REPORTING

- A presentation/overview for the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) was given by Dave McKay, Director of YouthBuild; along with Jim Myers of Gary Bess and Associates. Several CCP members commended Dave McKay on their collaborative efforts with the various agencies represented.

SUB-GROUPS/COMMITTEES

- Andy Pickett of the Butte County Administration's office requesting the ad hoc budget committee be reactivated. Chief Bordin stated that in the past the ad hoc committee consisted of the Sheriff's Office, Behavioral Health, and Probation. Chief Bordin polled the members present regarding using the same committee. All members agreed to reactivate the ad hoc budget committee.
