



## FAQs Restrictions of Commercial Cannabis in Butte County

### 1. How does the State licensing process work in California? Does Butte County recognize licenses, permits or other authorizations for commercial cannabis?

- a. Currently Butte County is not recognizing any State issued licenses or permits for commercial cannabis. The Butte County Board of Supervisors will revisit this topic in May 2018.

### 2. Are dispensaries or mobile dispensaries permitted in Butte County?

- a. Currently dispensaries are not permitted in Butte County; however, starting January 2018 Butte County will be allowing mobile dispensaries as long as the cannabis is being brought in from a different county.
- b. The CA state Bureau of Cannabis Control (BCC) will be issuing a “Distributor Transport-Only license for mobile dispensaries. This license allows you to transport cannabis and cannabis products, but not conduct any other functions of a dispensary.
- c. Requirements for the above listed BCC license are:
  - i. Cannabis must only be transported in a vehicle or trailer, not be visible from outside of the vehicle, and remain in a locked/secured box, container, or cage affixed to the vehicle.
  - ii. Vehicles must be equipped with a security system and remain secure at all times.
  - iii. Packages or containers containing cannabis cannot be opened or tampered with during transportation.
  - iv. No vehicle containing cannabis can be left unattended or overnight in a residential area.
  - v. All transports must have a shipping manifest with specific information about the cannabis and cannabis products being shipped. It must also identify the licensee shipping, transporting, and receiving the shipment.
- d. Beginning January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018, licensees shall not transport or sell any edible cannabis products exceeding 10 milligrams per serving and licensees shall not transport or sell any recreational or medicinal cannabis products exceeding 100 milligrams per package.

### 3. Is commercial cultivation permitted in Butte County?

- a. NO, currently any cultivation in the county must follow Butte County Code Chapter 34A and Chapter 34C, the two county ordinances in regards to cultivation.
