Resolution No.	Adoption Date	Summary of Amendments
Resolution 19-291	November 5, 2019	Incorporates the most current Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) as part of the Health and Safety Element of the General Plan in accordance with Assembly Bill (AB) 2140.
Resolution 18-068	April 24, 2018	Action Plan Update. The Action Plan was updated revising language of individual actions contained in the General Plan. This was the first update to the Action Plan since General Plan adoption in 2010.
Resolution 16-156	October 25, 2016	Amendments responding to the flood management requirements of Senate Bill SB-5 (2007) and the Central Valley Flood Protection Plan (CVFPP) including an urban 200-year flood protection overlay in the Land Use Element and adopting amendments to the General Plan Health and Safety Element providing mapping related to flood hazards and new text, an evaluation of critical facilities, incorporation of new policies and actions to reflect the CVFPP, and inclusion of new related terms and definitions.
Resolution 16-013 Final Supplemental EIR: Resolution 16-011	January 12, 2016	Amendments to Agricultural Element Policy AG-P5.3, applying buffers between residential development and lands designated by the General Plan as Agriculture. New policies AG-P5.3.1, AG-P5.3.2 and AG-P5.3.3 pertaining to the allowance of interim agricultural uses in residential, commercial and industrial zones; a residential setback for vineyards and orchards; and buffers between residential development and lands under existing Williamson Act contracts.
Resolution 15-077 Final Supplemental EIR: Resolution 15-077	May 19, 2015	Various amendments necessary to address the adoption of the Rio d' Oro Specific Plan, including new text describing the Plan.
Resolution 14-112	August 26, 2014	Certified Housing Element Update per State requirements (effective through June 15, 2022) Addition Military Planning Policies, text, and Overlay Map. Addition of Public Housing Overlay. LEED Policy (COS-P2.3) amended to address minor buildings Addition of Policies LU-P2.6 and Action LU-A2.1 concerning General Plan build-out and future General Plan Amendments.
Resolution 12-124 Final Supplemental EIR: Resolution 12-123	November 6, 2012	Amendment of Policy LU-P4.2 requiring HDR and VHDR land use designations to be developed at or above the minimum density range. Amendment of Policy LU-P13.4 regarding the Chico Area Greenline, specifying that RR and VLDR designations may occur on the Agricultural side of the Greenline as those designations are shown on the official Greenline map. Amendment of COS-P3.7 indicating that alternative energy facilities shall be encouraged in all General Plan designations.

Various amendments to COS-P5.2, -5.3, -5.5, -5.6 and -5.7, concerning minimizing air pollutant emissions.

Various amendments to the Health and Safety Element to address new floodplain mapping, Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazard Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan, and dam inundation.
