Gridley Community COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Open for Appointments on June 17th Offering Pfizer for 12+

BUTTE COUNTY, Calif. – Butte County Public Health (BCPH), in partnership with Enloe Medical Center and Orchard Hospital will host a community COVID-19 vaccination clinic in Gridley on Thursday June 17th at 200 East Spruce Street in Gridley from 3-5pm. Depending on demand, this is a one-time only clinic.

While appointments are encouraged, walk-ins are welcome. COVID-19 vaccinations are free of cost for all Californians, regardless of immigration status, or background. No ID required. Spanish translators will be available on site.
