The Butte County Library, Chico Branch Veteran Resources Station is looking for student veterans to assist us in helping other veterans get back to work.

Duties may include:

- Conducting intake interviews with veterans
- Referring veterans to outside services, based on their needs
- Helping veterans prepare resumes
- Answering and returning phone calls
- Answering questions from veteran's family members

To be eligible to work with Butte County Library, you must:

- Be using a VA educational benefit (Post-9/11 GI Bill, Reserve GI Bill, Dependents Ch. 35 benefit)
- Be taking at least 9 units per semester
- Be able to type at least 20 words per minute
- Be comfortable working with civilian and veteran staff, and veteran clients of all eras
- Be familiar with Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Outlook, and Internet Explorer.
- Be available to work 16+ hours per week.

What you get:

- \$9.00 per hour work, paid by the VA (this is nontaxable income)
- Flexible schedule; pick your classes, then set your work hours.
- Experience in a civilian office environment
- Training to help you succeed in your own future job searches
- The satisfaction of helping your fellow vets.
